#### **Teaching Narrative**

Since joining the Faculty of UCSF in 1996, my passion has been caring for, and teaching about, the care of elders. I have engaged in geriatrics education at the student, resident, fellow, and faculty level, as well as working across schools and disciplines. I feel passionately that the medical profession must become proficient in the care of elders before the Baby Boomers reach the age of 65 – 2010. I believe that UCSF can be a leading force in transforming medical education in the US, and geriatrics must be part of that transformation.

My educational philosophy is that adult learners learn best when they are highly engaged in their own learning and can see the relevance to their practice. Therefore, I see one of my key tasks as making geriatric medicine relevant, interesting, and compelling to all levels of learners. Additionally, we must also make

interdisciplinary care and the care of chronically ill patients as interesting as Wegener's granulomatosis and leishmaniasis if we are to meet the challenges of an aging population.

Finally, I believe that physicians must also be involved in transforming the health care system so that it more responsive to the needs of the patients. Education without serious structural change, will not produce improvements in patient care, no matter how well intentioned it might be.
